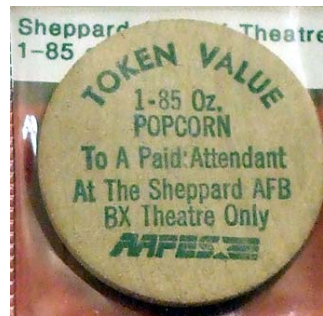
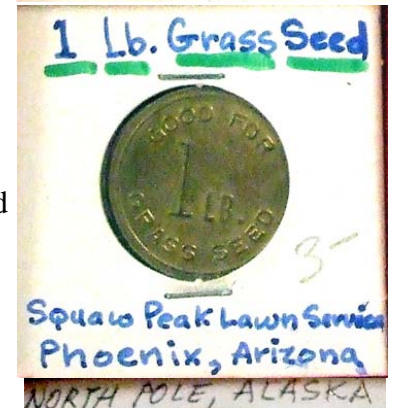
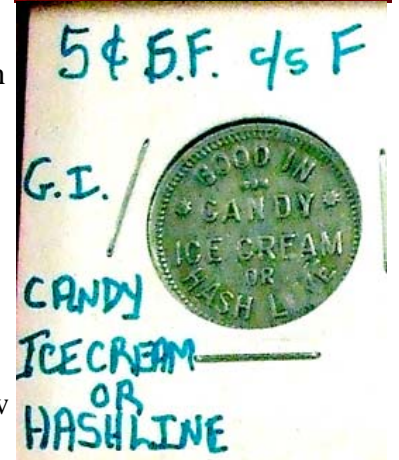

Vice President Chuck Call conducted the meeting. After reports by Recording Secretary Dorothy Galovich-Call, Treasurer Briita Ehlers and announcements, Briita Ehlers gave us a program on *Odd Denomination Tokens*. Some of the 28 tokens she brought were good for a popcorn, a shave, egg nog, a saddle, grass seed, a bath, check cashing and an imaginary ride. I'm unsure if Briita printed her own certificate for a job well done. Thanks Briita! Cliff Sherman won the show and tell drawing. Briita announced Harold and Joanne MacDonald recently celebrated their 50th anniversary (congratulations and happy anniversary!). Chuck Call dispatched 14 auction lots with one being a club donation. Kevin Silva and Ram Sethi ran the items. Robert Gatriex won the two peso gold in the raffle.

April 28 drew 38 attendees with one visitor. The bubble drawing was not won by member 738. Kris Martin won the door prize. 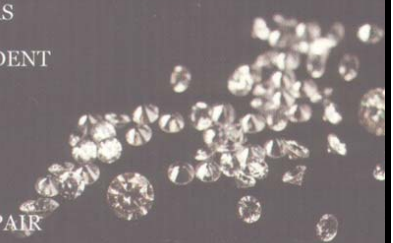

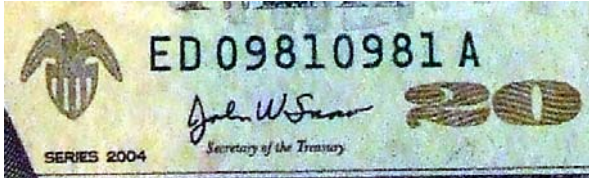
